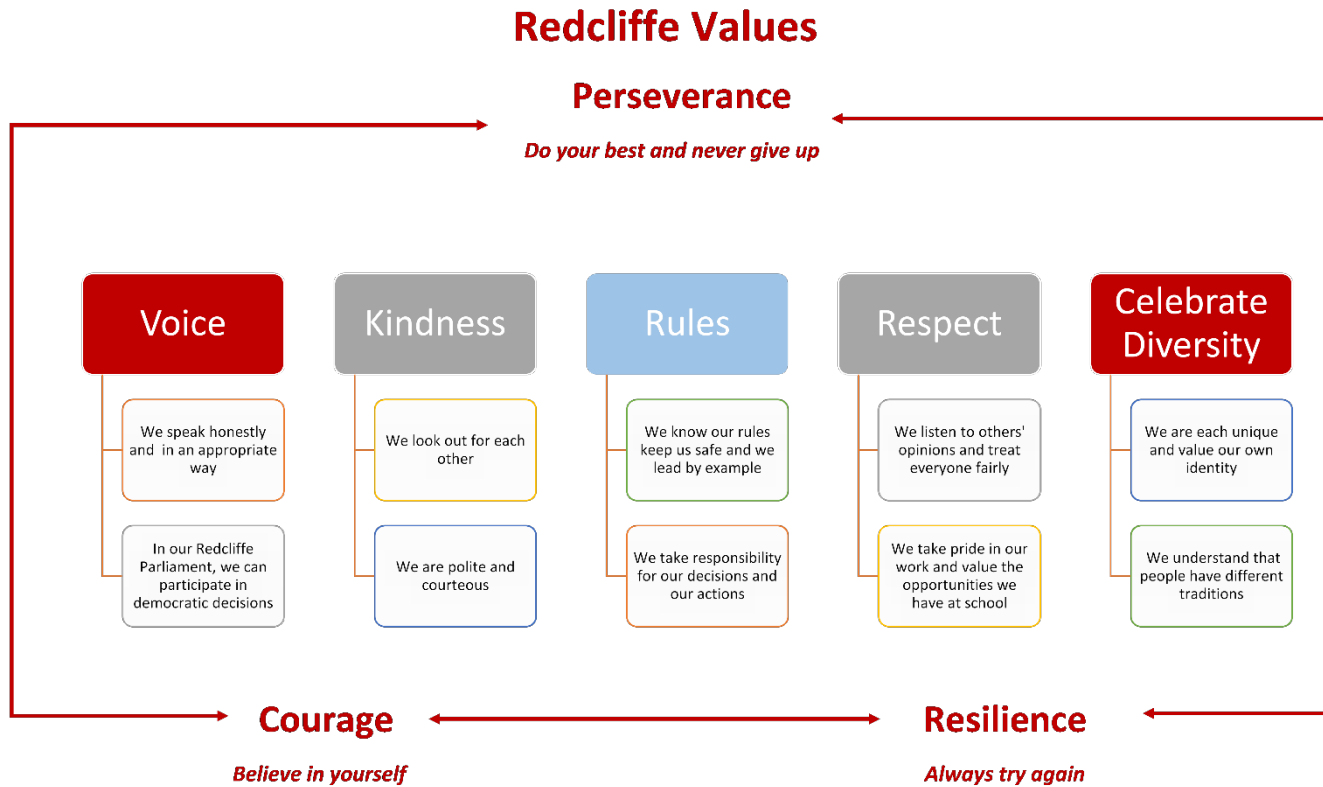

School Rules

The day to day school rules at Redcliffe have been formulated for the sake of the safety of the children. They are deliberately few but rigorously enforced:

- Children should walk, not run, in school
- When using the stairs the children should walk in single file and use the right-hand side (except during a fire drill)
- Children are not allowed in the playground or outside without an adult

In addition to these it is expected that **all** members of Redcliffe School's community should show respect for one another and pupils should:

- Consistently acknowledge the authority of their teachers and other adults and show them due respect
- Be well-mannered and attentive in class
- Respect their own and other people's property
- Take care of books and equipment
- Wear the correct uniform
- Not wear jewellery; however, small discreet stud earrings may be worn
- Be punctual.
